Our 7th Winter Festival is being given over to one of the most famous and most frequently performed song cycles: Franz Schubert's "Winter Journey". The cycle, which was composed in 1827, consists of 24 lieder. They relate the thoughts and feelings of a young wanderer who has to leave his beloved behind as he sets out alone into the winter's night. As he progresses, his moods change from exuberant joy to deep desperation. In the course of the five concert evenings we will be combining these lieder with new arrangements of Mendelssohn's "Songs Without Words", as well as works by Carl Maria von Weber, Max Bruch, Johannes Brahms and Leoš Janáček. At the closing concert we will also be presenting our latest Bürgenstock Festival CD album.

We are truly delighted that Benjamin Appl – the "front-runner of the new generation of lieder singers" (Gramophone Magazine, UK) will be performing "Winter Journey". You will also be able to enjoy performances by many other outstanding celebrated artists such as Boris Brovtsyn (violin), Amihai Grosz (viola), Timothy Park (cello) and the Swiss pianist Oliver Schnyder. And of course, you won't miss our artistic directors Andreas Ottensamer (clarinet) and José Gallardo (piano).
